All funds in the Tax Incremental District Number Five Fund shall be used solely for those purposes expressly stated and reasonably inferred in SDCL Chapter 11-9
- 6. **Adoption of Tax Increment Plan.** The City Council of the City of Box Elder does hereby adopt the Tax Increment Plan Number Five as presented.
