NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: The Board of Commissioners of Valley County will conduct combined public hearings on July 31, 2023, at 5:30 p.m. at the Valley County Courthouse in the Commissioner's room, 219 N Main Street Cascade, Idaho.


PURPOSE OF THE HEARING ON PETITION TO FORM A NEW COUNTYWIDE AMBULANCE DISTRICT AND TO DISSOLVE THE VALLEY COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICE DISTRICT:

· To hear and consider agency and public comment on the above referenced filed Petition to create a new ambulance district pursuant to Idaho Code Section 31-3911 and call for a special election on the question.

· To hear and consider agency and public comment concerning the above referenced filed Petition to dissolve the existing ambulance district; subject to the County Commissioners granting the Petition to create the new ambulance district, and subject to the voters' approval of the formation of the new ambulance district.

PURPOSE OF THE HEARING ON THE PERMANENT OVERRIDE ELECTION:

· To hear and consider agency and public comment on the current Ambulance District Board of Commissioners' intent to call for a permanent override special election to authorize the Ambulance District to permanently increase its base property tax levy not to exceed four-hundredths percent (.04%) of market value for assessment purposes. A successful override election is necessary to enable a new ambulance district board of commissioners to establish such a levy.
