## C. U.P. 21-31 Hamblin Sawmill

Applicant/Owner: Melinda Voicu and James Hamblin

Location: 14100 Norwood Road

#### **Project Description:**

Melinda Voicu and James Hamblin are requesting a conditional use permit for a portable sawmill within a 3,000-sqft pole-barn. The maximum building height will be 25-ft. A variance is requested from the required minimum 75-ft frontage on a public road to allow the building to be 75-ft from the western property line and approximately 1,450-ft from Norwood Road (VCC 9-5F-1A2).

Additional trees and bushes would be planted for screening.

C.U.P. 21-02, approved March 23, 2021, allows three residential homes on this parcel and a shop to support a home-based masonry business.

An existing shared-driveway easement would be used to access to the site from Norwood Road. The 32-acre site is addressed at 14100 Norwood RD.

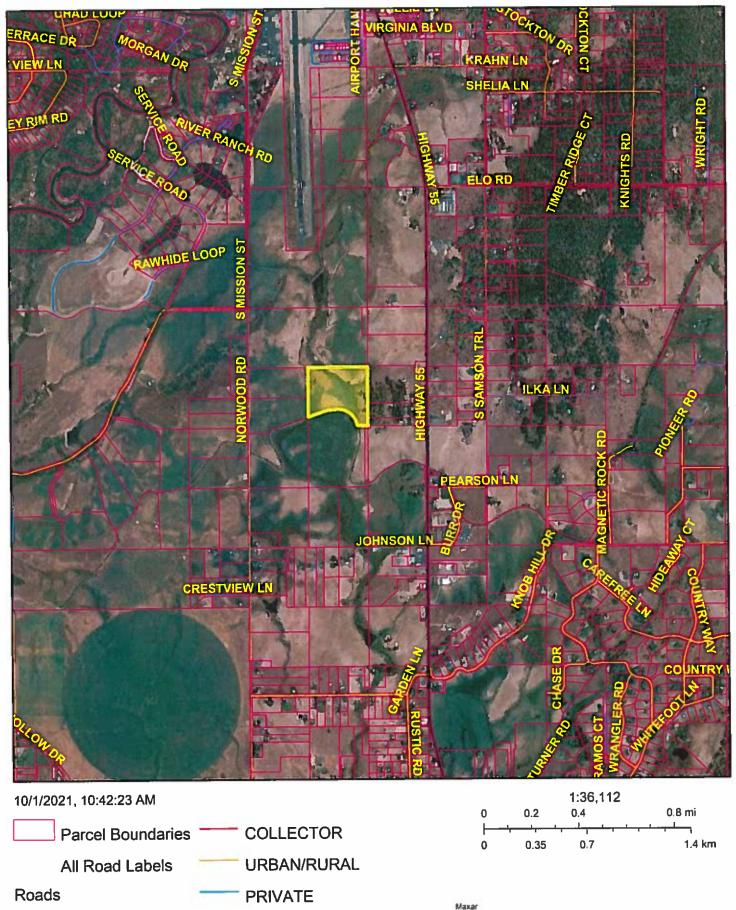

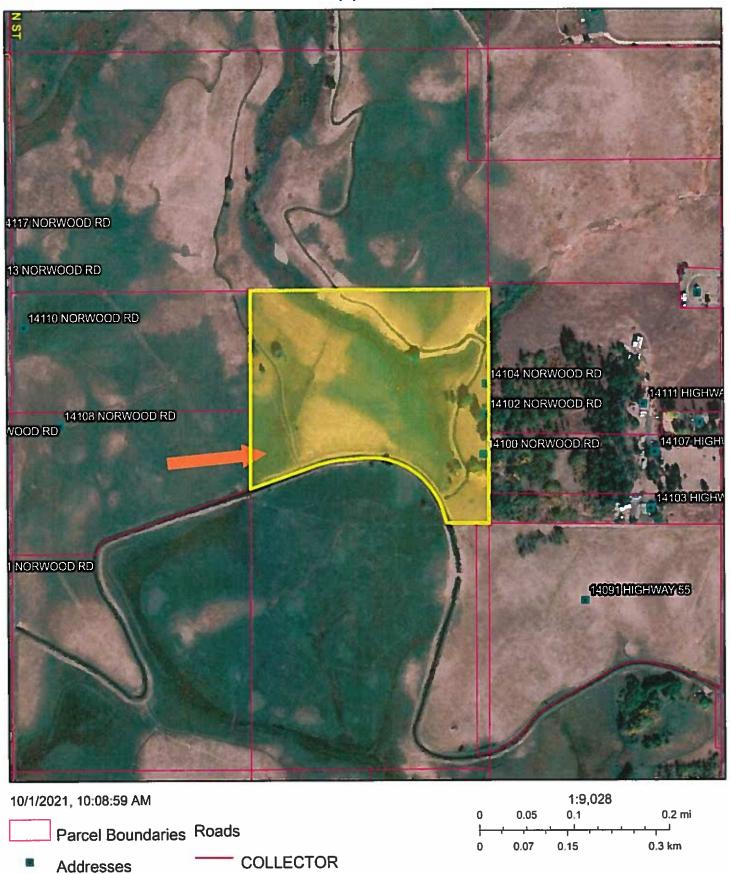
# C.U.P. 21-31 Vicinity Map
