

Proposed Increase of Public Administration Fees for Valley County Department of Motor Vehicles

Idaho Statute states that "... a board of county commissioners may impose and collect fees for those services provided by the county that would otherwise be funded by ad valorem tax revenues. The fees collected pursuant to this section shall be reasonably related to, but shall not exceed, the actual cost of the service being rendered.

The Valley County Department of Motor Vehicle office has experienced a 50% decrease in registration administrative fee revenue due to the centralization of renewals to Idaho Transportation Department and a 30% decrease in title fee revenue. Valley County Assessor Sue Leeper has analyzed different fee options and determine that an increase of \$15 would cover, but not exceed, the fiscal year 2024 budget.

The Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing on the proposed fee increase. If approved the title administration fee would increase from \$3.00 to \$18.00, effective July 1, 2023.
