Purpose:

This exhibit is submitted in support of Appellants' concerns regarding traffic impacts, roadway safety, and the adequacy of agency review associated with CUP 26-012.

The correspondence reflects that ITD reviewed the proposal based upon representations that the facility would generate approximately four (4) trips per day and specifically indicated that "4 trips/day is not a concern." The correspondence further requested notification if trip generation was expected to change from that assumption.

Appellants contend that the record does not demonstrate that ITD reviewed or approved the increased traffic activity ultimately authorized through the approval process. The exhibit is offered to demonstrate that agency review may have been based upon assumptions different from those reflected in the final approval and to support Appellants' concerns regarding traffic impacts, roadway safety, and the adequacy of the record.

Appellants offer this exhibit in support of Sections III, IV, and V of the Appeal.
