**Craw County
Comprehensive
Plan**

Mississippi River Regional Planning Commission has submitted a proposal to complete the Crawford County Comprehensive Plan, which is due for renewal in 2027. The amount of the proposal is \$29,750.

Motion by Krachey; second by Jerrett to accept the proposal from Mississippi River Regional Planning Commission (MRRPC) in the amount of \$29,750 to complete a new Comprehensive Plan for Crawford County beginning with year 2027. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

**2025 Chargeback
Request**

Every year in January, the State of Wisconsin sends out the previous year's approved chargeback requests. Because this amount varies from year to year, it is difficult to predict what the county will owe and what to budget for. The amount budgeted for the 2025 Approved Chargeback Requests was \$4,000. The amount due is \$6,812.94.

Deanne Lutz, Treasurer, is requesting guidance from where to pull the additional funds for payment of these assessors' errors.

Motion by Krachey; second by Jerrett to fund the remaining amount of \$2,812.94 from the contingency fund. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

**County Treas
Report**

The updated Sales & Use and Wheel Tax revenue reports were distributed to the committee members for review today.

Sales & Use Tax in February 2026 increased 5% from February 2025. Wheel Tax information for January 2026 decreased 7% from January of 2025.

The capital projects (new jail) phase 2 fund balance was \$579,950.01 as of March 19th, 2026.
