New business: Laura told the committee that for 2026 we
will be getting \$12,273.00 for grant money from the state.
We reduced the transportation grant money by \$200.00 and
requested \$1,000.00 more for care of graves but that could
change. Otherwise, the budget is the same. Gilberts made
a motion to approve the 2026 budget request and Rocksvold
seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Molly Bohn talked a little bit about veterans programs.

room.

A motion was made by Rocksvold to adjourn. Gilberts
