The Committee called to order February 24, 2025, in Suite 125 Aging & Disability Resource Center Conference Room at 9:30. Present were members of the Aging Committee: Craig Anderson, Linda Munson, and Gary Koch. Members of the Advisory Committee: Ed Block, Pat Dearth, Jill Doll, Wade Dull, Gerald Rau, and Wanda Everson. ADRC Operations Report- Nutrition, Transportation, NFCSP, Information & Assistance, Elder and Disability Benefit Specialists, Outreach, Budget, Regional Board:

Board Education – Transportation Drive – Jayme Jensen presented on his role as a transportation driver and his experiences with clients and the impact the ADRC has on them.

Jacob handed out the operations report and reported on the home delivered meals, congregate dining, and transportation programs for year-to-date 2026. Nicole reported on the Caregiver programs, Information and Assistance data, Disability Benefit data, and Elder Benefit data.

Director and Staff Report- Nicole reported Mara Mathis has been with us for 1 month. She has passed her required LTCFS Certification exam and went to Richland County to shadow their ADRC Specialist. Health Promotions classes are set for 2026. Strong Bodies is going on now and two Strong Bodies classes, PALS, and PALS 2.0 classes will start in March. ADRC Specialists had 7 LTCFS in 2026 vs 6 in 2025 in January. They have 18 open cases vs 5 in 2025. There were 5 enrolments in 2026 vs 2 in January 2025. EBS top topic is clients that have lost their insurance. Many are realizing that their pharmacy does not cover their insurance anymore. ADRC office will be in the St. Patrick's day parade on March 14th.

Advocacy Issues – Inclsua will be moving to a MTM as their transportation broker. All their current contracts end 3/31/26. Those individuals/businesses can contract with MTM. The Save Act will place more hurdles to be able to vote.
