

The Crawford County Highway Committee held their regular meeting on Thursday, March 19th, 2026, at the Crawford County Highway Department conference room in Seneca, WI. The meeting was called to order by County Board Chairman Tom Cornford at 9:24 a.m. Proof of Publication was verified by Tom Cornford.

Members present were Gerry Krachey, Derek Flansburgh and County Board Chairman Tom Cornford. Carl Orr arrived at 9:28 a.m. Mark Gilberts and Bruce Strnad were excused. Also present was Commissioner Kyle Kozelka, State Highway Superintendent Terry Hird, County Highway Superintendent Dave Jones and Shop Superintendent Cory Folbrecht. Julie Check was present to take minutes.

Minutes from the last regular meeting on Thursday, February 19th, 2026, were approved by a motion made by Gerry Krachey, second by Derek Flansburgh. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Gerry Krachey made a motion to authorize payment of Invoice Vouchers #: 58-69, 72-96 & 99-141; and Payroll Vouchers #: 70, 71, 97 & 98; second by Derek Flansburgh. Motion carried by a roll call vote.

Recognition of Guests:

- Branden (BJ) Halverson from Fahrner Asphalt Sealers, LLC and Jesse Werner from H.G Meigs were present for the opening of the bids for the 2026 County Highway Improvement Projects; Oil and Emulsions.

Annual Report:

- **Annual Report** – Gerry Krachey made a motion to approve the Annual Report and forward to county board, second by Derek Flansburgh. Motion carried by a voice vote.

Fund Balances, Transfer of Funds, Invoice Adjustments – Past Due Accounts:

- **Fund Balances** – Fund balances dated 02/27/2026 were reviewed.

State Trunk Highways:

- **STH Update** – State Highway Superintendent Terry Hird informed the committee the state crew: have been doing winter maintenance; doing a little patching, brushing and picking up windfalls. Terry Hird discussed with the committee the upcoming WisDOT projects: sealcoating from Vernon County to CTH H on STH 61 all in one project; a DMA for approximately \$100,000.00 for wedging on STH 35; a small LFA for bird net install and maintenance on STH 60. Will be meeting with WisDOT to discuss maintenance during and after improvement projects; shoulders and culverts; 2028 project from Wauzeka to Boscobel; and 2030 project from Lynxville to Ferryville.

County Trunk Highways:

- **CTH Update** – County Highway Superintendent Dave Jones informed the committee that the county crew have been brushing for Town of Prairie du Chien, on the Ambro and some on Gran Grae. All the sand sheds are full except for Seneca. Also, crack sealing and winter maintenance work.
- **CTH W (STH 61 to Richland County Line) – CHI-S – Resurface Project** – Commissioner Kozelka explained he received a \$500,000.00 CHI-S Resurface Project for the east side of CTH W. Project will widen the road from 22' to 24'. Several properties appear to be encroaching on Right-of-Way, so the Commissioner recommends hiring a surveyor to stake out R/W near these apparent encroachments. Tom Cornford made a motion to move forward with getting proposals for R/W staking and encroachments, second by Derek Flansburgh. Motion carried by voice vote.

Local Projects and Bridges:

- **2026 Bridge Inspection Contract** – Commissioner Kozelka explained that the bridge inspection contract from Jewell Associates Engineers, Inc. went up \$15 per bridge, from \$280 to \$295 per structure. Gerry Krachey made a motion to approve the 2026 Bridge Inspection Contract with Jewell Associates Engineers, Inc., second by Derek Flansburgh. Motion carried by a roll call vote.

Highway Buildings, Facilities and Equipment:

- **Gays Mills/Soldiers Grove Shop Location** – One week after the February Highway Meeting, Commissioner Kozelka submitted an appropriations request for approximately \$4.5 million to Molly Bohm at Van Orden's office. He did not include site work & design costs. If we don't receive the 1st round, he will resubmit for 2028 funding.
- **Farm Lease Excess Property – Update** - The governmental agency that contacted Commissioner Kozelka about the sale of this excess property did not want to come to the March Highway Committee meeting. They'd prefer to meet with the committee on site.

Bids, Proposals, Sales or Misc.:

- **Culvert Bids** - Cory Folbrecht, Shop Superintendent, stated he got bids from both Contech and Metal Culverts for the first order for 2026 and all culvert bids. Tom Cornford made a motion to approve both bids due to product pricing and availability; second by Gerry Krachey. Motion carried by a roll call vote.
- **Proposal Requests – 2026 County Highway Improvement Projects – Open & Approve Bids:** (See attachment A)
 - **Proposal One – Hot Mix Asphalt* (LT-4 & MT-4 Hot Mix Asphalt, 6,000 tons more or less)** - Received bids from Iverson Construction, Inc. for Proposal One and Proposal One Alternate Bid* and Scott Construction, Inc. for Proposal One only. Gerry Krachey made a motion to approve bids from Iverson Construction, Inc. due to plant location in Crawford County, (also approved Scott Construction, Inc. bid contingent on no plant availability from Iverson Construction, Inc.), second by Derek Flansburgh. Motion carried by a roll call vote. ***This material may be used for projects funded through the Local Road Improvement Program.** (Low bid was Scott Construction per ton but not cost effective for Crawford County to haul from Jackson Plant, when Iverson Construction has plants in Crawford County). (See attachments #1 & #2).
 - **Proposal Two – 3/8" Minus Hot Mix (LT-5) Thin Lay Asphalt, 1,100 tons, more or less** – Received bids from Iverson Construction, Inc. and Scott Construction, Inc. for Proposal Two. Gerry Krachey made a motion to approve bid from both Iverson Construction and Scott Construction, bids contingent on product and plant availability, second by Derek Flansburgh. Motion carried by a voice vote. (See attachments #1 & #3).
 - **Proposal Three – 3/8" Minus Cold Mix Asphalt, 500 tons, more or less** – Received bids from Iverson Construction, Inc. and Scott Construction, Inc. for Proposal Three. Gerry Krachey made a motion to approve bid from both Iverson Construction and Scott Construction, bids contingent on product and plant availability, second by Derek Flansburgh. Motion carried by a voice vote. (See attachments #1 & #4).

- **Proposal Requests – 2026 County Highway Improvement Projects – Open & Approve Bids:** (continued)
 - **Proposal Four – Seal Coat Chips - 3,000 tons more or less of 3/8” Limestone Chips; AND 2,000 tons more or less Quartz or Fractured River Stone Chips –** Received bids from Fahrner Asphalt for chips and hauling; and from Prairie Sand and Gravel for chips only for Proposal Four. Gerry Krachey made a motion to approve low bid from Prairie Sand and Gravel for 3/8” limestone chips and fractured granite chips, second by Derek Flansburgh. Motion carried by a voice vote. (See attachments #5 & #6).
 - **Proposal Five – Base Aggregate –** Approximately 7,500 ton more or less of Limestone Breaker and/or Crushed Select, as well as approximately 3,000 ton more or less of 3/4” Limestone BAD - Received only one bid from Prairie Sand & Gravel with book pricing. Will reference and use for future projects. (See attachment #6).
- **Sealcoat Oil/Emulsions & Application Requests – Open and Approve Bids –**
 - **Sealcoat Oil/Emulsions & Applications Requests –** Received bids from H.G.Meigs and Flint Hills Resources for oil/emulsions and from Fahrner Asphalt Sealers, LLC for application for Flint Hills. Derek Flansburgh made a motion to go with the low bid from H.G.Meigs for the oil/emulsions and application, second by Gerry Krachey. Motion carried by a roll call vote. (See attachments #7, #8 & #9). Discussed looking into and going with a polymer base for our county sealcoating. We want to make sure we use the correct type of polymer for the exact type of rock we go with. Gerry Krachey made a motion to give Commissioner Kozelka and the Superintendents the authority and flexibility to make the decision on the type of polymer used on the county projects, second by Derek. Motion carried by a roll call vote.

Variance Request(s), Disposal of Right of Way, Easements, Misc.:

- **CTH X – Werthwein –** Commissioner Kozelka updated the committee who he had been in contact with and the discussions. Since the ground is still frozen discussed waiting to see what progress is made in the coming weeks/month. The committee and commissioner discussed options for moving forward to rectifying this issue.

Personnel and Personnel Issues:

- **Employee Vacancy –** Commissioner Kozelka informed the committee that the highway department is now fully staffed. Jordan Tracy was hired from the last group interviewed. He started on Monday and has done a really good job so far. He did very good on his first time out on his route.
- **Class A CDL Expense Reimbursement –** An individual on the crew is looking to obtain their Class A CDL and inquired about costs being covered by the County. The committee is willing to assist if it does not conflict with how we’ve handled these cases in the past. They directed the commissioner to confirm pricing and past practice, and report back to them next month.







As a result of the closed session(s), no motions were made.





The Crawford County Highway Department will receive Sealed Bids only for the following County Highway Improvement Projects at the Crawford County Highway Department, 21515 State Highway 27, P.O. Box 39, Seneca, Wisconsin 54654, until 2:00 pm on Wednesday, March 18th, 2026. Bids will be opened, read aloud, and considered on Thursday, March 19th, 2026, during the monthly Highway Committee meeting.

Proposal One – Hot Mix Asphalt*

Crawford County is requesting proposals for LT-4 and MT-4 Hot Mix Asphalt, 6,000 tons (more or less), to be produced and dumped into trucks provided by Crawford County. Bid shall be quoted per ton, and prices should be quoted from any/all potential plant locations. Plant location, time of material delivery and a schedule shall be agreed upon by Crawford County and the successful bidder. At the time of main line production, Crawford County shall have full access to the asphalt plant.

Alternate Bid: Contractor to supply Labor, Equipment and Material to provide, place and compact for the above quoted hot mix asphalt, including tack materials.

***Note:** This material may be used for projects funded through the Local Road Improvement Program.

Proposal Two – 3/8" Minus Hot Mix Thin Lay Asphalt

Bids will also be received for 3/8 Inch Minus (LT-5) Hot Mix Asphalt, 1,100 tons (more or less). Bid is to be per ton, for the construction season asphalt needs for county, state, and local roads. Bidder to provide plant for material to be dumped into trucks provided by Crawford County along with plant locations and times that they will set and be available throughout the construction season.

Proposal Three – Cold Mix Asphalt

Bids will also be received for 3/8 Inch Minus Cold Mix Asphalt, 500 tons (more or less). Bid is to be per ton, for the construction season asphalt needs for county, state, and local roads. Bidder to provide plant for material to be dumped into trucks provided by Crawford County along with plant locations and times that they will set and be available throughout the construction season. Bidder to specify dates Cold Mix Asphalt will be produced along with plant location.

Proposal Four – Sealcoat Chips

Bids will also be received for 3,000 tons (more or less) of 3/8-inch Limestone Chips, AND 2,000 tons (more or less) Quartz, or Fractured River Stone Chips. Bid is to be per ton, picked up by Crawford County.

Proposal Five – Base Aggregate

Bids will also be received for approximately 7,500 ton (more or less) of Limestone Breaker and/or Crushed Select, as well as approximately 3,000 ton (more or less) of 3/4" Limestone BAD. Bid is to be per ton, picked up by Crawford County. Project Location: CTH W between STH 61 and Richland County Line.

All materials shall meet Wisconsin Department of Transportation specifications.
