Agenda:

1. **Call to Order** by the Honorable Lukas Steiner at 1:02 PM.
2. **Roll Call**
3. **Justice Programs (Treatment Court / Diversion):**
 - a. 4th Quarter Reporting and Fiscal Report – Update provided by Susan Hilger. Fiscal numbers provided and indicates turned back \$60,000.
 - b. MOU – Update provided by Susan Hilger. Forms circulating to parties needing to sign. Have some with today to hand out. Would like this MOU in place prior to doing the 2027 funding.
 - c. Trainings – Update provided by Susan Hilger. Quite a few trainings this year for both diversion and treatment court. Crawford County Treatment Court team is speaking at WATCP. Funding approved to go to the National Conference in Oklahoma, Nashville, and Reno.
 - d. Update regarding TAD spending – Update provided by Susan Hilger. Last year was zero. This year at \$12,000 right now. Spending is currently on track. Testing Specialist will be leaving at the end of March 2026 as he gave his two-week notice. Working out future testing with Sheriff's Department and Jail. Will hold that position open for funding purposes. She will get a process set up with the Sheriff's Department after March 29, 2026.
4. **Circuit Court:**
 - a. Security Assessment – Update provided by Lukas Steiner. Motion needed in CJCC. Any discussions on the security report by Sgt. Johnson must be processed through Security and Facilities Committee instead of this committee. Nancy asks clarification question. Heidi answers that it is in accordance with SCR 68.05 Security and Facilities Committee and that it is not a public meeting. Motion made by Lukas Steiner. Seconded by Brad Steiner. No opposition. Motion carried with no negative votes cast.
 - b. Bond forms / Warrants – Update by Lukas Steiner. Money has been paid and then defendants were released with no new court date. When people are permitted

to post cash and be released, they need to have a new court date. Will make a point that bond amounts are put on the forms. Non-standard conditions need to be added to the form as well.

5. Law Enforcement:

a. Update by Ryan Fradette. He talked with Dale McCullick for any updates. Discussed the first two floors of the Sheriff's Department remodel and indicates that possibly in April they will be able to get into their offices. Says that they have a plan for the testing to assist Treatment Court. There is a speed grant that was obtained and the Sheriff's Department will be conducting more stops and people will see increased law enforcement. Officers are trying to do positive public relations and that started last week. Gives an update on the good cooperation with Human Services when the need arises.

6. Old Business:

a. By-Laws ad hoc committee (Luke, Heidi, Andrew, Brad) - Update by Andrew. Indicates he sent information around to the other ad hoc members today for review. Discussed a subcommittee vote and then bring to the main CJCC committee. This is tabled until the next meeting. Expect a motion on approval in June.

7. New Business:

a. Dan McWilliams gives an update on peer support through Human Services with Next Steps for Change. He was told about the grant and waiting to hear formally. Starts in March.

b. Charlotte Wynes indicates appreciation of being able to go through the jail tour last month with the entire SPD team.
