III. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION

A. Financial Statement

The budget was allocated approximately one month ago. At this time, there is little variance, with a slight surplus due to the absence of a Director of Curriculum. However, increased facilities expenses have offset much of that surplus. Minor adjustments have occurred, but the overall budget remains on track and is not expected to change after only one month.

Energy expenditures are projected to remain within budget. The current contract with Constellation is set to expire in the coming months. Mr. Bucci has been exploring options to transition to a new energy supplier in coordination with the town, but efforts have not yet been successful. He noted that energy rates have been as low as \$0.10/kWh and is interested in locking in a rate at that level. Mr. Bucci will be reaching out to Constellation to explore their current offerings.

The annual audit has been completed. All books have been closed, reconciled, and submitted as of 10/1/25. There were no issues or findings—everything was in order and we passed with flying colors.
